#### LEGAL HISTORIES

Employment Specialists help individuals assist with job search that is attainable. Matching job preferences that can be sustainable regardless of legalities.

## SYMPTOMS OF MENTAL ILLNESS

Using the team approach, Employment Specialists help by communicating with IPS teams to provide follow along s supports that correlate with mental health services to achieve and maintain competitive employment.

#### **DECISIONS ABOUT PERSONAL INFORMATION**

The Employment Specialist honors the individual's mental health preferences and treatment. Employment Specialists will continually discuss decisions to disclose, or not disclose personal health information and personal presentation to the employer.

#### MISSED APPOINTMENTS

The Employment Specialist will continue to work with the individual's team to reach their job goal without judgement.

### SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS

IPS programs do not try to change people before helping them with employment. The Employment Specialist will help support their availability preferences and social support networks while keeping their safety and integrity in mind.

## **UNSTABLE HOUSING OR HOMELESSNESS**

The Employment Specialist will listen to the individuals needs and limitations to help assist in finding employment that can be retained when experiencing housing barriers.

#### PAST PROBLEMS WITH EMPLOYMENT

Employment Specialists consider each person's strengths and do not focus on work histories that have had problems. The Employment Specialist will work on job development skills to support the individual with job retention as the goal.

# **IPS Supported Employment**



TEAM APPROACH=SUCCESS
The 8 IPS Practice Principles

- 1. Every person who wants to work is eligible for IPS (zero exclusion).
- 2. Competitive jobs are the goal.
- IPS services are integrated with mental health treatment.
- Personalized benefits planning is provided.
- 5. The job search starts soon after a person expresses interest in working.
- Employment Specialists build relationships with employers based on their client's work preferences.
- 7. Individual job supports are time limited.
- 8. Client preferences are honored.

# Vocational Rehabilitation & IPS



Vocational Rehabilitation Counselors help people identify employment goals and the services they need to return to work. IPS programs collaborate with VR (Vocational Rehabilitation) counselors for people who have active cases in both systems. Collaboration ensures that each person has just one employment plan from both systems. Employment Specialists and VR counselors also meet in person at least once each month to share information and ideas to help people achieve their goals.

The IPS team is a collaborative effort between
Productive Alternatives Inc., Douglas County,
Region 4 South, including Pope, Grant, Traverse and
Stevens counties, Morrison County, Vocational
Rehabilitation, Alexandria Lakeland Mental Health,
Horizon Public Health, and Vikingland Community Support.
Referrals are assigned to an Employment Specialist and the
Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor to identify job goals and
supports necessary to obtain employment.
